

RM OF COTEAU, NO 255

Bylaw 3-2017

SPEED CONTROL BYLAW

Council of the RM of Coteau, No 255, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enact as follows:

1. Purpose and Intent

- a. The purpose of this bylaw is to regulate the speed of motor vehicles;
- b. Identify areas within the RM of Coteau, No 255 where reduced speed applies and;
- c. Set out the penalties and / or fines for those persons who exceed speed limits.

2. Definitions

In this bylaw:

- a. **"Council"** shall mean the Reeve and Councillors of the Rural Municipality of Coteau, No 255 elected pursuant to the provisions of *The Local Government Election Act, 2015*.
- b. **"RM"** or **"Municipality"** shall mean the Rural Municipality of Coteau, No 255.
- c. **"Highway"** means any public highway or roadway within the Municipality under the direction, control, and management of the Municipality and **"public highway"** means a public highway as defined by the *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997*.
- d. **"Motor vehicle"** means a motor vehicle as defined by or pursuant to *The Traffic Safety Act*.

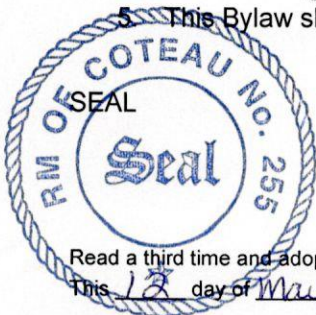
3. Provisions

- a. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than which is posted on any highway.
- b. All highways within the Municipality shall not exceed 80km per hour with the exception of those highways which are identified in *Schedule A*, which forms part of this Bylaw, for which will have a reduced speed.
- c. No person shall deface, injure, destroy, or remove any speed limit sign or marker erected in accordance with the provisions of this Bylaw.

4. Enforcement

- a. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a penalty of that identified in *Schedule B*, which forms part of this Bylaw.
- b. Enforcement of this Bylaw may be made by a Bylaw Enforcement Officer and / or Peace Officer duly appointed for the enforcement of Municipal Bylaws.

5. This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the date of its final adoption.

SPEED CONTROL BYLAW

SCHEDULE A

1. Roads and/or highways shall have a maximum speed posting of 30km per hour within the following locations:
 - a. Hamlet of Birsay
 - b. Hamlet of Dunblane

2. Roads and/or highways shall have a maximum speed posting of 25km per hour within the following locations:
 - a. Organized Hamlet of Hitchcock Bay

3. Roads and/or highways shall have a maximum speed posting of 40km per hour within the following locations:
 - a. Access road from Highway 45 to Sandy Shores Resort

4. Roads and/or highways shall have a maximum speed posting of 20km per hour within the following locations:
 - a. Sandy Shores Resort

SCHEDULE B

1. Penalties
 - a. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a penalty of \$150.00.
