

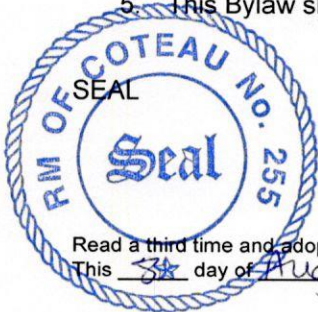
RM OF COTEAU, NO 255

Bylaw 7-2017

GOLF CART & ATV BYLAW

Council of the RM of Coteau, No 255, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enact as follows:

1. Purpose and Intent
  - a. The purpose of this bylaw is to regulate and control the operation of golf carts and ATV's;
  - b. Set out the penalties and / or fines for those persons who contravene any provision of this bylaw.
  
2. Definitions  
In this bylaw:
  - a. "**Council**" shall mean the Reeve and Councillors of the Rural Municipality of Coteau, No 255 elected pursuant to the provisions of *The Local Government Election Act, 2015*.
  - b. "**RM**" or "**Municipality**" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Coteau, No 255.
  - c. "**All Terrain Vehicle**" or "**ATV**" means an all terrain vehicle as defined in *The All Terrain Vehicles Act*.
  - d. "**Operate**" means to use or operate, or be in actual physical control of an all terrain vehicle or golf cart.
  
3. Provisions
  - a. No person shall operate an ATV or golf cart without a valid driver's license.
  
4. Enforcement
  - a. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a penalty of that identified in *Schedule A*, which forms part of this Bylaw.
  - b. Enforcement of this Bylaw may be made by a Bylaw Enforcement Officer and / or Peace Officer duly appointed for the enforcement of Municipal Bylaws.
  
5. This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the date of its final adoption.



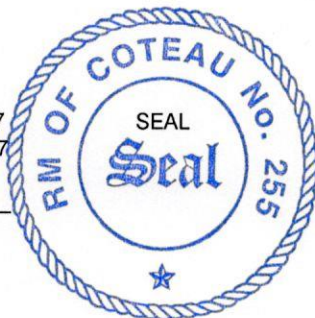

**SCHEDULE A**

1. Penalties

Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the following penalty(s):

- a. First Offense \$150.00
- b. Second and Continuing Offenses \$300.00
